Venue:

Birštonas is a charming resort town in Lithuania, nestled along the picturesque banks of the Nemunas River. Known for its mineral springs and healing properties, Birštonas has been a popular destination for relaxation and wellness for centuries. The town is surrounded by lush forests and offers a tranquil atmosphere, making

Transportation:

Birštonas can be reached:

- by car via the A1 (exit 66) from Vilnius or Kaunas, or via the A16 from Vilnius or the south of Lithuania (*Poland/Marijampolė*).
- by bus from Vilnius or Kaunas bus stations. You can check bus schedules, ticket fares, and buy tickets here: [Bus Tickets](#).

Transportation from Vilnius International Airport (VNO), Kaunas International Airport (KUN), or Palanga International Airport (PLQ) can be arranged upon request. Requests must be submitted to the organizers well in advance (together with the entries), and no later than 26 July 2025. The transfer price per person will be calculated based on the number of applicants.

Accommodation:

Important. Competitors are responsible for arranging their own accommodation, and it is highly recommended to make these arrangements well in advance.

The organizers have negotiated a special deal with *Sanatorium Egle*, offering exclusive rates for ARDF competitors. This option includes full board, access to the swimming pool, sauna, and other amenities. The organizers strongly encourage participants to stay at *Sanatorium Egle* to enjoy these benefits and the convenience of the recommended accommodation.

Visa requirement:

Lithuania is a member of the European Union and the Schengen Area. Participants of the 22nd IARU World ARDF Championships are advised to check whether they require a visa to enter Lithuania.

Entry fees:

Competitors: EUR 70 per competition. Full package EUR 280 per whole event (registration, transport to start and from finish, souvenirs, hamfest etc.).

Team officials: EUR 40 per competition. Full package EUR 160 per whole event (registration, transport to start and from finish, souvenirs, hamfest etc.).

Visitors: EUR 15 per competition (*transport to finish and back*). EUR 60 per whole event.

Hamfest (separate fee for visitors): EUR 35

Important. The above-mentioned fees apply until 15 June 2025. Payments made after 15 June 2025 will incur a 50% late fee.

Competition rules:

Terrain, weather and clothing:

The competition areas are characterized by gently rolling hills, sandy soil, and a mix of pine and broadleaf forests. The landscape features numerous deep ravines, small valleys, occasional marshes, and forest clearings.

In August, competitors can expect mild weather conditions, with daytime temperatures typically ranging from 20°C to 25°C. While the month is generally dry and sunny, occasional rain showers are possible.

There are no regulations regarding clothing. The choice of footwear is free. Please note that ticks may be present in the competition terrain, appropriate precautions are highly recommended.

Transmitters and antennas:

3.5 MHz transmitters (classics)

- RF power 3W
- frequency: 3.53 MHz, finish beacon: 3.60 MHz
- antenna: 8m vertical + 8 m single radial counterpoise

144 MHz transmitters (classics)

- RF power 1W
- frequency: TX 1-5: 144.50 MHz, finish beacon: 144.85 MHz
- antenna: crossed dipoles 2.5 m above ground level

3.5 MHz transmitters for sprint

- RF power 1 W
- frequency:
 - TX 1-5: 3.53 MHz
 - spectators control (S): 3.55 MHz
 - TX 1F-5F: 3.57 MHz
 - finish beacon: 3.60 MHz
- antenna: 8m vertical + 8 m single radial counterpoise

3.5 MHz transmitters for foxoring

- RF power 10 mW, beacon: 1W
- frequency:
 - TX 1, 2, 1F, 2F: 3.53 MHz
 - TX 3, 4, 3F, 4F: 3.55 MHz
 - TX 5, 5F: 3.57 MHz
 - finish beacon: 3.60 MHz
- antenna:
 - field transmitters 30 cm vertical + no counterpoise,
 - finish beacon 8m vertical + 8 m single radial counterpoise

Marking devices:

SportIdent system (not SIAC) will be used, control numbers and bands will be written on the SI unit.

Medical Care and Insurance:

First aid facilities will be available at the finish areas for all competitions. There is no cost to participants for on-site minor treatment, however the cost of ambulance transportation, emergency department visits, or clinic visits will be the participant's responsibility. Therefore, we strongly recommend purchasing insurance that covers such expenses.


Note on thunderstorm:

In the event of a severe thunderstorm, the Chairman of the Jury may recall the competition (according to Rule 27.5). In such a case, this will be announced to competitors by switching off all transmitters except the beacon and TX No. 1, which will remain operating continuously. Competitors must proceed to the finish immediately.

Embargoed area:

As of the publishing date of this bulletin, it is forbidden to train or move around in any forested area within the highlighted areas below. Allowed exceptions are official orienteering or ARDF events organized by Lithuanian Orienteering Federation or Lithuanian Amateur Radio Society.
